

Further considerations:

*Increased enrollment

*Class-size Memorandum of Understanding with Hollister Elementary School Teachers Association (HESTA) that allows for the TK-3 district-wide average to be 26.5 with a cap of 29 students. This agreement expires June 30, 2022. Without the agreement, HSD will need to hire more teachers and open more classrooms which will impact our facilities and budget constraints.

*190 students on RISE that may reintegrate onto physical campuses
