Expected Outcomes of field trip: Students will express vocabulary and build background knowledge of summer camp culture through real life experiences. This year the Migrant Summer School will have a camping theme, Camp- Learn- A- Lot. Every year, students go away for the summer and have camp experiences that foster independence, learning, and recreational fun. Part of that summer camp culture is to go swimming in a nearby lake or pool. We would like to provide the same experience to our Migrant students. Swimming is a life skill and an area that they are assessed in their future high school physical education classes. We are trying to provide experiences that will level the playing field for students and leave a positive impact on them as well.
