Impact on HSD students



HSD's UPK program intends to reduce gaps in learning opportunities and outcomes for early learners by disrupting inequities and providing equitable opportunities by providing a 4 year programmatic rollout beginning in August 2022.





Beginning in August 2022 all children who are turning 5 between February 3 and the end of the school year living within Hollister School District boundaries are eligible to enroll and begin classes August 17, 2022.
